Nearly ten years ago, I came to Fort Bragg and found more than a place to live—I found my home. I met my wife, who was raising four children, and together we welcomed a daughter.

My formal education ended after eighth grade, and I am working toward my GED. My greatest education has come through family, hard work, and serving others.

From ages 16 to 18, I completed eight Northwest Youth Corps sessions. Six weeks working on Mount Hood, including the Pacific Crest Trail, taught me perseverance and teamwork. I am CPR certified and spent three years with Parents & Friends supporting people with disabilities.

In 2017, I started my detailing business door-to-door with a bicycle and basic supplies. Today, I have 60-plus five-star reviews and counting.

I care deeply about people, mental health, and recognizing our first responders, caregivers, doctors, and nurses who serve our community.

After a Fort Bragg resident died in a July 23 collision on Cypress Street, I believe we must improve pedestrian safety, including better-lit crosswalks and addressing alleyway blind spots.

Fort Bragg gave me a place to build my life. I want to give back by serving the community.
